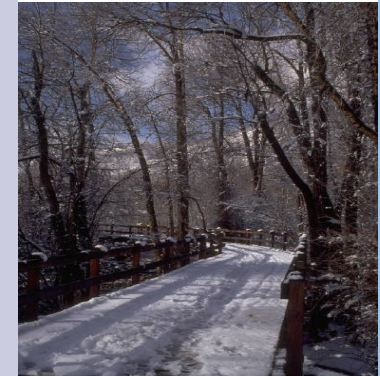

CEW IN OUR COMMUNITY

The **Lincoln Highway Christian Experience Weekend (CEW)** is a spiritual renewal retreat - a shared religious experience that grew out of the realization that the Christian life has to be experienced before it can be properly appreciated. The renewal of one's life in Christ is the focus as each participant examines their relationship with self, others and God. Since the Christian life is a community life, it is best experienced in community with other **Companions on the Journey!**

CEW is a time to discover and develop insights into questions inside of you about yourself, your faith life and what it means to be a follower of Jesus. It is a way to nourish one's individual spirituality and be a part of the greater Christian community that Jesus came to earth to establish.

Both the women's and men's weekends are held at the scenic Pilgrim Heights Camp & Retreat Center near Montour, IA. This retreat weekend is for those 18 years of age and older. Weekends begin at 7:00PM on Friday and end at 4:00PM on Sunday. Participants sleep at the retreat site to maintain the community experience. Arrangements will be made for those with special needs. All meals are provided. Special dietary needs can be accommodated. Please note them on your registration form). A team of lay people, priests, deacons and/or sisters serve as leaders for the weekend.

Pilgrim Heights is located just north of Highway 30, 12 miles east of Marshalltown, 5 miles west of Toledo. Turn north, from Highway 30 onto E Avenue, 1.5 miles west of the casino. Pilgrim Heights is at the end of a gravel road.
Do not follow Google or MapQuest as those directions will take you South on E Avenue into Montour.
Look for the big blue signs that say *Pilgrim Heights Camp & Retreat Center*. If you get lost, call the director and someone will meet you!
